

Notification by executor of the death of a recorded person

In the event of the death of a recorded person, their executor must notify the keeper of the recorded person's death as soon as reasonably practicable.

To allow the keeper to remove all the deceased recorded person's entries from RCI, the executor is required to provide:

- the recorded person's reference number, if known
- the recorded person's name
- the recorded person's address
- the recorded person's land details the title number(s) if the affected land is registered within the land register or a sufficient property description if the land is recorded within Registers of Sasines
- the date of the recorded person's death

The executor must also provide a copy of the death certificate of the recorded person.

It is acceptable for a solicitor to notify the keeper about the death of a recorded person on behalf of the executor, provided that they have the authority to act for the executor and can evidence this.

How to submit the notification of death of a recorded person

- 1. Fill in this notification form
- 2. Print the form and sign the declaration. A scanned image of a wet signed declaration is acceptable
- 3. Provide a copy of the recorded person's death certificate
- 4. Send your completed form and death certificate to us by email to RCI@ros.gov.uk please be aware that we will not accept information via post or to any alternative Registers of Scotland email addresses.
